PEE WEE PIG SHOW INFORMATION

The purpose of this class is to design a swine project to fit the physical size and maturity level of younger youth and give youth a fun project exposing them to the experience of caring for and showing livestock.

This is an open class show managed by the Mitchell County Fair Board. Entry fee is \$5.00. Entries are due to the Extension Office by July 25, 2025.

Entrants will receive a participation ribbon. No premiums will be awarded. There will not be an overall champion. Animals in this class are not eligible for the ribbon auction.

One entry per participant.

Age/classes: Grade completed May 2025.

5 years old – 1st grade – Junior

2nd-3rd grade – Intermediate

Junior 4-H - Senior

Health requirements follow general county fair guidelines. (No boars) Pigs should be market weight.

Judging will be based on:

- 1. What participant has learned about care and raising of the pig.
- 2. The fitting and showing of the pig.
- 3. General health condition and management of the pig.

Judging will be Thursday, July 31st immediately following the Swine Show.

Pigs will be checked in 30 minutes to one hour prior to the show and can leave immediately after the show.
